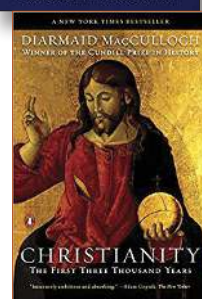
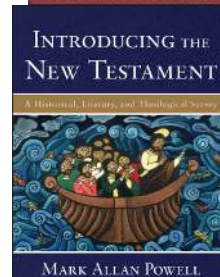
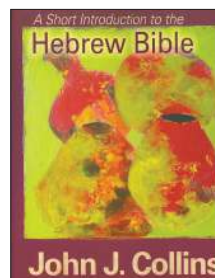
The Prayer Ministry Need You!
