Vestry Resolution On Pasadena Unified School District Parcel Tax, May 2010

Adopted by the Vestry of All Saints Church, Pasadena, on February 2, 2010

Whereas All Saints Church is committed to the well-being of all children in Pasadena and has declared itself a Sanctuary for Children,

Whereas education matters to our young people by providing them the tools to lead fulfilling lives, become contributing citizens and to compete in a challenging global economy,

Whereas education matters to our entire community because good public schools build a stronger workforce, attract talented people into our businesses, educational and cultural institutions and our non-profits, support the local economy and enhance the quality of life for the entire community,

Whereas good public schools reduce school dropout, delinquency, crime, incarcerations and welfare costs,

Whereas having absorbed \$31 million in cuts already, further cuts due to the state financial crisis will translate into an additional \$20 million a year reduction for Pasadena Unified School District after which the annual budget will be \$154 million,

Whereas additional cuts will result in an increase in class sizes, laying off 100 or more teachers, closing school libraries, cutting advanced instruction in math, science and technology as well as advanced placement and college prep courses, reducing health and security services, cutting art, music, and career training education,

Be it Resolved that the Vestry of All Saints Church will support the District's campaign for a parcel tax through its endorsement of the parcel tax.
