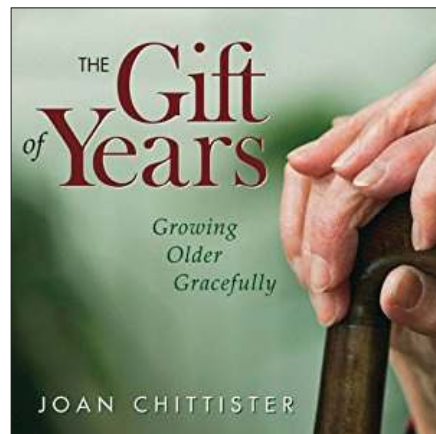
LGBTQ Mentors

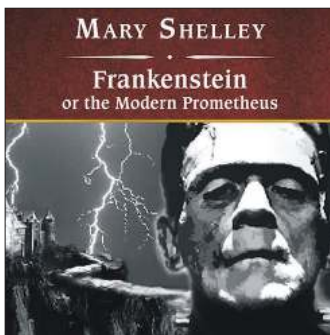


Fiction Fun! Reads *Frankenstein: Or, The Modern Prometheus* by Mary Shelley

1831. Scholars argue about which edition is better, and for our purposes people can read whichever edition they'd prefer. We assume *Frankenstein* needs no introduction; not only have there been dozens of films based on it, but there's a Wikipedia entry on "Frankenstein in Popular Culture." Mary Shelley wrote it as a teenager; she was the daughter of two great individuals, William Godwin and Mary Wollstonecraft, and the wife of another, Percy Bysshe Shelley.
