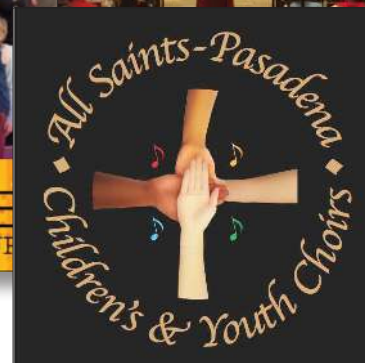
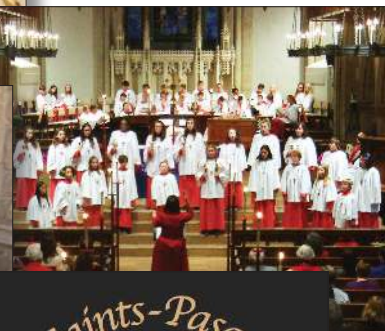

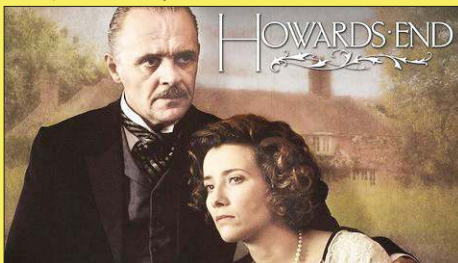

Need Free Legal Help?

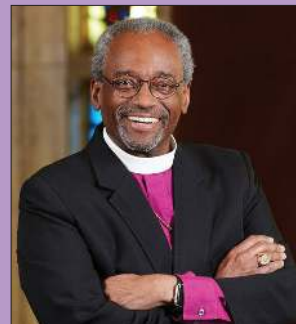
