Finally, we call on them to reduce prison and jail populations as much as possible through all available mechanisms of release. No one should be punished for illness and no one deserves to die in this pandemic, including those who are incarcerated.

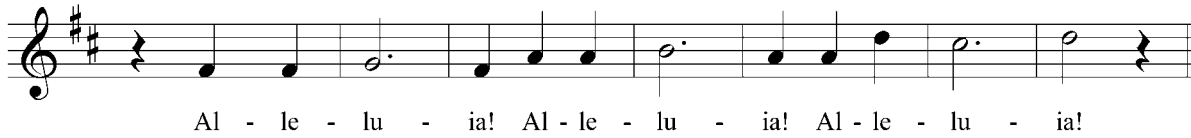

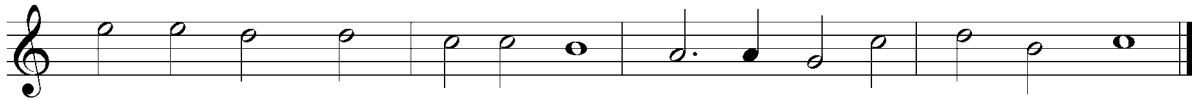
