Ministro: Las Buenas Nuevas de Jesucristo como está escrito en San Juan (10: 1–10).

Pueblo: Gloria a ti, Cristo Señor.

Entonces Jesús dijo: «Les aseguro que el que no entra en el redil de las ovejas por la puerta es un ladrón y un bandido. Pero el que entra por la puerta es el pastor que cuida las ovejas. El portero le abre la puerta, y el pastor llama a cada oveja por su nombre, y las ovejas reconocen su voz; las saca del redil, y cuando ya han salido todas, camina delante de ellas, y las ovejas lo siguen porque reconocen su voz. En cambio, a un desconocido no lo siguen, sino que huyen de él, porque desconocen su voz.» Jesús les puso esta comparación, pero ellos no entendieron lo que les quería decir. Jesús volvió a decirles: «Esto les aseguro: Yo soy la puerta por donde pasan las ovejas. Todos los que vinieron antes de mí, fueron unos ladrones y unos bandidos; pero las ovejas no les hicieron caso. Yo soy la puerta: el que por mí entre, se salvará. Será como una oveja que entra y sale y encuentra pastos.» El ladrón viene solamente para robar, matar y destruir; pero yo he venido para que tengan vida, y para que la tengan en abundancia.»

Minister: The Good News of Jesus as written in John (10:1–10).

Jesus said, "Very truly, I tell you, anyone who does not enter the sheepfold by the gate but climbs in by another way is a thief and a bandit. The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens the gate for the shepherd, whose voice the sheep hear, calling each one by name and leading them out. Having brought them out, the shepherd goes on ahead of them, and the sheep follow because they know the shepherd's voice. The sheep will not follow a stranger, but they will run away because they do not know the voice of strangers." Jesus used this figure of speech with them, but they did not understand what he was saying to them. So again Jesus said to them, "Very truly, I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and bandits; but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters by me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly."

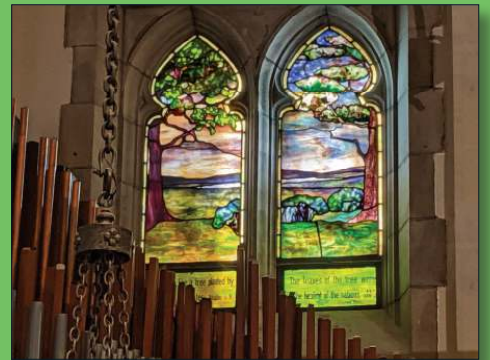

Scott Budnick Joins Us For Our Rector's Forum at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, May 10

Despite a red-hot career **Scott Budnick** abruptly left the film business in 2013 to start a prisoner-advocacy nonprofit. He recently returned to film-making with a vision to pair storytelling with real-world impact. In 2013, Budnick launched the Anti-Recidivism Coalition (ARC), which advocates for policy change and provides mentoring for the incarcerated and recently released. ARC helped get 14

bills signed into law by former California Gov. Jerry Brown, including one that gives a shot at freedom to 20,000 juveniles sentenced to life without parole. But Budnick, 43, couldn't quite shake his storytelling roots: In 2018, as an offshoot of ARC, the Atlanta native created production banner One Community. Its first project, Warner Bros. *Just Mercy*, based on the book of world-renowned civil rights defense attorney Bryan Stevenson works to free a wrongly condemned death row prisoner.



Budnick was inspired to bring prisoners' stories to film and TV not long after starting ARC. "I met a guy at a party who was involved in the marriage equality movement and asked him what was the game-changing moment," Budnick recalls. "He said, 'Will & Grace, Ellen DeGeneres, Glee, Modern Family, Milk.' That was a decade of content that changed people's hearts and minds and how they voted throughout the country or just made them less dug-in against gay marriage. When I heard that, I realized that I'm able to really scale the work we're doing by raising money for a film and television company."



We Welcome Back Andre Henry Preaching at 11:15 a.m. on Sunday, May 17

Andre Henry is managing editor at *RELEVANT* Media Group. He holds a B.A. in Practical Theology and an M.A. in Theology with an emphasis in Biblical Languages. After watching a black man bleed to death on Face Book Live in 2016, I decided (if you can call it that) to lug a 100-pound granite boulder around Los Angeles for 6 months, to demonstrate the burden that systemic racism lays on the black psyche. I took it to work, to class, on job interviews, to dinner with friends—everywhere—singing as I went. That path has led me through the work of great freedom fighters of the past like Gandhi and Mandela and Martin Luther King. All of this searching

has shown me that history isn't a story that's happening to us, but one we're writing together. Therefore, we don't have to feel helpless about the overwhelming brokenness in the world. We have the power to take meaningful action.
