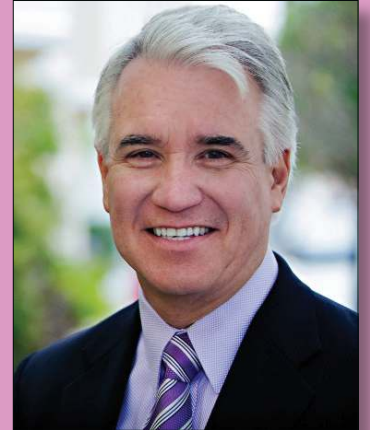

Join us for a special Summer Rector's Forum as we welcome the candidates for LA District Attorney incumbent Los Angeles DA **Jackie Lacey** and former San Francisco DA **George Gascón**.



Jackie Lacey is the first woman and first African-American to serve as Los Angeles County District Attorney since the office was established in 1850. A lifelong Democrat, she has spent most of her professional life as a prosecutor, manager and executive in the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office. As chair of the Criminal Justice Mental Health Project for Los Angeles County, District Attorney Lacey leads a multidisciplinary working group devoted to diverting people who are mentally ill out of the criminal justice system for nonviolent offenses.

Former District Attorney for the City & County of San Francisco, and former Assistant Chief of the Los Angeles Police Department, George Gascón is running for District Attorney to modernize LA's criminal justice system. He has spent his life working to make sure our justice system works for everyone, not just the wealthy & well-connected.
