

All Saints Church COVID-19 Protocol
For In-Person Participation in a Small Group (10 or fewer people) – Outdoors only
Information for Facilitator

A. Practices to protect small group participants' health

Facilitators should conduct their own symptom check before they begin small group activities. Check must include cough, shortness of breath, fever and other symptoms (see ASC COVID-19 Screening for Employees). Facilitators should not lead small group gatherings if they are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms.

Facilitators should instruct all participants not to attend the group if they are sick (i.e., have COVID-19 symptoms) or if they have been exposed to a person who has COVID-19.

Facilitators should verify that participants are symptom-free before they enter the group. A verbal check-in should include a verification of no symptoms of cough, shortness of breath, fever and other symptoms, as well as a verification that participants have not had contact with someone who has COVID-19. Participants who do not pass the verbal symptom check and contact verification should not attend the group.

B. Measures to ensure physical distancing

The total number of participants in the group, including participants and group facilitators, may not exceed 10.

To the extent feasible, groups are scheduled at times that will not lead to overcrowding as participants arrive at gathering site.

Seating in the group gathering space is arranged to permit at least 6 feet of space between participants.

C. Measures for infection control

All group participants must wear a face covering at all times during the small group gathering (except children aged 2 years and younger). Participants who refuse should not attend the group.

No smoking is permitted. Food and drinks should not be shared except between members of the same household.

Hand sanitizer is made available for small group participants. If a bathroom is available for use, participants should be encouraged to wash hands with soap and wipe down surfaces after use.

Participants should be instructed to not share items such as service liturgies with group members who are not from the same household.

Any items which are used during the small group gathering should be wiped down after the gathering concludes.
