

## Kelly Erin's Suggestion List for Advent Wreath Supplies:

Buy them ASAP so you have everything ready to go for Advent One. Links are to amazon because it is the only place I know to get Advent candles online for cheap and easy ... but you can likely find these other places too.

- **Wreath:**

A plain green wreath (Trader Joes often has these for around \$10 AFTER thanksgiving) You will need string if you want to use loose greens!
