RE: Support responsible nuclear disarmament policy

Dear Members of Congress,

As a person of faith and your constituent, I support Congress passing S.Res.323/H.Res.317 to ensure the threat of nuclear weapons is eliminated. My faith guides me to advocate for a more peaceful Earth. With the expiration of the New START treaty in February, we have entered a new time of uncertainty around nuclear weapons. The resolution intends to:

- Lead the effort for all nuclear-armed states to eliminate the option of using nuclear weapons.
- Implement effective checks and balances on the president's sole authority to initiate nuclear use.
- End the Cold War-era hair-trigger alert posture, which increases the risk of catastrophe in a crisis.
- End plans to produce and deploy new nuclear warheads and delivery systems, reducing taxpayer burdens.
- Consider the past and current environmental and societal implications of nuclear weapons usage and provide health monitoring, compensation, and medical care to those who have and will be harmed by nuclear weapons usage.
- Plan economic transitions for the workforces involved in the development, testing, production, management, and dismantlement of nuclear weapons to communities that are economically dependent on nuclear weapons production and management.

I urge you to support this resolution's passage.
