Re: Support the Right of a Woman to Choose an Abortion

Dear Members of Congress,

As your constituent, I am writing to ask that you take action to support the right of women to choose an abortion if they feel, in consultation with their doctors and families, that an abortion is the best option given their circumstances.

I am outraged by the law passed and signed in Texas that makes abortion illegal after six weeks, a point in the pregnancy when most women don't even know they are pregnant, and that turns enforcement over to a vigilante mechanism that is designed to skirt court scrutiny.

I am also outraged by the failure of the Supreme Court to block a blatantly unconstitutional law. The majority's specious reasoning against an injunction betrays a prejudiced agenda against a woman's right to choose.

In the face of this, I am demanding that Congress pass legislation to codify Roe vs. Wade into law and urge that Congress seriously consider legislation to rebalance what has obviously become an ideologically tilted Supreme Court!
