Japan's Process for Buying a Gun

- **1** Join a hunting or shooting club.
- Take a firearm class and pass a written exam,
- which is held up to three times a year.
- 3 Get a doctor's note saying you are mentally fit and do not have a history of drug abuse.
- 4 Apply for a permit to take firing training, which may take up to a month.
- 5 Describe in a police interview why you need a gun.

Pass a review of your criminal history, gun possession record, employment, involvement with

- 6 organized crime groups, personal debt and relationships with friends, family and neighbors.
- 7 Apply for a gunpowder permit.
- 8 Take a one-day training class and pass a firing test.
- 9 Obtain a certificate from a gun dealer describing the gun you want.
- 10 Buy a gun safe and an ammunition locker that meet safety regulations.
- 11 Allow police to inspect your gun
- Pass an additional background
- review.
- 13 Buy a gun.
