Dear Members of Congress,		
With the beginning of a new Congress and the backdrop of mass shootings in Monterey Park and Half Moon Bay, I am writing once again to express my sadness and outrage over the level of gun violence that we experience in our country. An experience that no other developed country shares. In fact, there are few developing countries that share this experience.		
I support a ban on assault weapons and high capacity magazines, a comprehensive system of background checks for the purchasing of guns and ammunition, the elimination of online guns ales and the establishment of a minimum age of 21 for the purchase of guns and ammunition.		
We need federal legislation on this. The Monterey Park shooting manifestly demonstrated that. Those murders were committed with a gun purchased in Arizona that would have been illegal in California.		
I urge you to work towards these goals. We cannot continue like this.
