**RE: Please support The Dream Act of 2023 (S.365)**

Dear Members of Congress,

As an Episcopalian and your constituent, I am writing to urge you to commit to passing legislation that provides legal status for Dreamers, individuals who arrived as undocumented immigrants as children.

The Episcopal Church has advocated for passing the Dream Act since 2012 when it called on Congress to pass "federal legislation that presents a pathway to citizenship for undocumented youth and young adults." Polls also consistently show that Americans across the political spectrum support providing Dreamers with a pathway to citizenship, showing that protecting Dreamers is an issue that brings Americans together instead of dividing them.

Congress has options for protecting Dreamers. Senators Graham and Durbin reintroduced the Dream Act of 2023 (S.365). Given that Congress has tried to fix this issue since 2001 without making progress in protecting Dreamers, my neighbors deserve a chance to become full-fledged members of my community after making the United States their home. Please commit to passing legislation protecting Dreamers by the end of 2023.
